

Quarterly Community Outreach

(July - September 2022)



For our third quarter community outreach project, NAWIC Pikes Peak Chapter 356 has chosen to help with the current needs of Safe Passage. Safe Passage is at the center of an inter-agency collaborative effort that minimizes the trauma to victims of child abuse by centralizing services in one, child-friendly location. They act as team leader, coordinating the responses of their team partners in the medical, investigative, social service, legal, and mental health arenas. This holistic approach keeps investigations child-focused and ensures that children and caregivers receive the broadest range of support in the least intrusive manner possible. Annually, Safe Passage serves more than 1200 children, ranging from birth to the age of 18, as well as intellectually developmentally disabled adults, who are victims of sexual or physical abuse and/or are witnesses to homicide or domestic violence, and non-offending caregivers in the midst of abuse investigations. Safe Passage serves El Paso and Teller Counties as well as referrals from additional counties throughout Colorado and their services are always provided free of charge.

When victims and their families go into Safe Passage for services, each child in the family leaves with a gift to help promote a positive experience during a difficult time. While Safe Passage serves a wide range of ages, from birth to the age of 18, they are currently in need of more items to have on hand for the teens that come into the facility. Some of the items that we can donate to help them are:

- \$5 \$10 gift cards for coffee (Dutch Bros or Starbucks) or fast food (ex. McDonalds, Taco Bell, Subway, Chick-fil-a, Burger King, etc.)
- Headphones or ear buds (\$5 \$20 range)
- Journals
- Art supplies, art kits, or cool pens See Amazon wish list for ideas
- LED Lights See Amazon wish list for ideas

  - You can have the items shipped to you and bring them to a meeting or have them shipped to Rampart Tile Company and we will do one big drop off at our October membership meeting. Also, if you purchase from the Wishlist, then reference NAWIC in the comments section so that they know where the items came from.

For the months of July, August, and September, our chapter will be collecting these items to help support Safe Passage. You can bring your items to a membership meeting or contact Samantha Walter to arrange for pick up or drop off. We will do a big donation to the facility, in October, at our membership meeting.






