Community Outreach

For the month of December, we will be collaborating with God's Pantry to "adopt" two families in need for the Christmas holiday.

Family 1 – A woman has been raising her two-year-old nephew, since his birth, own her own. He was born addicted to heroin. She has been unable to get the birth parents to relinquish custody of the boy and is unable to get any assistance because he is not hers. She works full time, but she is still struggling.

Family 2 – A past volunteer has developed stage four cancer. He is 34 years old and has four children (15 y/o boy, 14 y/o boy, 12 y/o boy and a 5 y/o girl). He was let go at work, and no one will hire him due to the cancer. His wife is a stay at home mother as their youngest daughter has special needs. They purchased a house right before he was diagnosed with cancer and since he can't find work they are struggling.

The goal is for our chapter to help both families in need, not just by purchasing gifts for the children, but also by helping to provide items that they are in need of, including some gift cards for groceries. I have received the wish lists for both families and I've compiled the information on Giftster.com, direct link on bottom of this page.

We can accept monetary donations (cash, check, Venmo) to put towards items not purchased as well as to donate directly to Family 2. Please contact Samantha Walter directly to make arrangements for a donation.

If there are some items that are not purchased by Tuesday, December 6, then we will plan for a group shopping trip on either Saturday, December 10, or Sunday, December 11. Specific date and time TBD based on how much is still needed. Please feel free to let me know ahead of time if one of these dates is better for you. Any items purchased before then, can be dropped off or shipped directly to Rampart Tile Company (3405 North El Paso Street, Colorado Springs, CO 80907) and we'll have them onsite for our gift wrapping evening.

The group wrapping night will be held at Rampart Tile Company's office (3405 North El Paso Street, 80907), on Tuesday, December 13, starting around 5:30 pm. Please bring wrapping paper, bows, tags, and scissors to help wrap the gifts that we collect.

We will be turning in the gifts to God's Pantry (30 Widefield Blvd., Colorado Springs, CO 80911) on Saturday, December 17, at 1:00 pm. Anyone that would like to come to help transport gifts and be at the drop off is welcome to be there. Please let me know who will be there so that I include you in any specific communications.




