The first quarter of 2023 is already in full swing, and we'll be helping First Tee – Southern Colorado, now through March, for our Community Outreach endeavors. First Tee is a youth development organization that enables kids to build the strength of character that empowers them through a lifetime of new challenges. By seamlessly integrating the game of golf with a life skills curriculum, First Tee creates active learning experiences that build inner strength, self-confidence, and resilience that kids can carry to everything they do.

First Tee has a detailed Wishlist set up that includes sets of golf clubs that they use as rentals for their participants, putter sets that the 3 & 4 year olds, that they refer to as Little Chippers, use when they are starting out, training equipment used for golf warm ups, and board games that will be used for a new monthly birthday event that they are implementing for their regular attendees from their core program.

You can purchase items and bring them to the February membership meeting or to the Gals on the Green Event where we will be presenting First Tee with all the items that the chapter has purchased for them. If it's easier for you, then feel free to order from the Wishlist and have the order sent to Rampart Tile Company and Samantha will store them until donation day.

The volunteer registration process does require each volunteer to complete a background check (fee \$20.50 to be paid by the volunteer for the initial BGC) and to complete an online SafeSport Training (takes two hours to complete).
