(February – March 2023)

The first quarter of 2023 is already in full swing, and we'll be helping First Tee – Southern Colorado, now through March, for our Community Outreach endeavors. First Tee is a youth development organization that enables kids to build the strength of character that empowers them through a lifetime of new challenges. By seamlessly integrating the game of golf with a life skills curriculum, First Tee creates active learning experiences that build inner strength, self-confidence, and resilience that kids can carry to everything they do.

First Tee has a detailed Wishlist set up that includes sets of golf clubs that they use as rentals for their participants, putter sets that the 3 & 4 year olds, that they refer to as Little Chippers, use when they are starting out, training equipment used for golf warm ups, and board games that will be used for a new monthly birthday event that they are implementing for their regular attendees from their core program.

You can purchase items and bring them to the February membership meeting or to the Gals on the Green Event where we will be presenting First Tee with all the items that the chapter has purchased for them. For our second quarter community outreach, we will have two volunteer opportunities at the National Mill Dog Rescue in Peyton. NMDR is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, and their mission is:

To rescue, rehabilitate and rehome discarded breeding dogs and to educate the general public about the cruel realities of the commercial dog breeding industry.

National Mill Dog Rescue was established in February 2007, in honor of a forgiving little Italian Greyhound named Lily. Theresa Strader, NMDR's Founder and Executive Director, rescued Lily from a dog auction in Missouri. Prior to that day, Lily had spent the first seven years of her life as a commercial breeding dog, a puppy mill mom. Determined that her years of living in misery would not be in vain, Strader started NMDR, giving a voice to mill dogs across the country. NMDR volunteer coordinator, Joni Williams, will take our group through a brief group orientation and tour of the shelter. After that, our group will get into the kennels and interact with the dogs, help with spot cleaning, take several dogs out to an indoor or outdoor play yard for a 'Puppy Party', take bigger dogs on a pack walk, etc.

Important things to note for volunteer day:

It is best to wear comfortable clothes, wear layers depending on the weather, and clothes toed shoes.

Bring a water bottle.

The maximum number of people in our group will be 15 people.

Volunteers must be at least 15 years of age. Those between 15-18 years of age must be accompanied by an adult at all times.

Anyone 18 and older can sign a waiver at the kennel upon arrival.


